The successful candidate will gain knowledge of sand blasting, industrial painting, paint equipment and painting processes, including how to ensure job specifications and quality control processes are met. This position will be required to wear company-provided respiratory protective equipment and follow all policies and procedures for safety; specific WHMIS training will also be provided.

Required Education, Skills & Abilities

Minimum Grade 12 education and a valid driver's licence is required. Previous industrial sand blasting experience and forklift operator certification are considered assets. This position may require work to be performed indoors and outdoors; as well as physical exertion to carry and set up workpieces for blasting (weight handling up to 27kg; 60 lbs). Please note that DyMark Industries is engaged in work activities defined by *OH and S Regulations* as high hazard work. Due to the safety hazards associated with steel fabrication, building erection, and working at construction and mine sites, safety is a bona fide occupational requirement and DyMark Industries has a zero tolerance policy for any employee that reports to work impaired on any DyMark worksite. <u>All employees must arrive to work fit for duty.</u>
